On the other hand, Leiden's attraction resulted from its academic achievements which are traced back to the conditions in the United Provinces, the limited influence of the Calvinist church, Leiden's professors as well as the university's facilities. The core of this study is an exhaustive quantitative study of the composition of the Leiden student population in general and that of its English segment. In particular, information is provided on the duration of the studies of English students at Leiden, their age, social background, and fields of study. We learn about the careers of English students both prior to and after their time at Leiden and of the motivation that led the English to choose Leiden over other continental universities.
